Acute Low Back Pain

Do you have moderate to severe low back pain that started in the last 30 days?

Do you have pain that extends into your lower leg below the knee?

The Study Purpose

- To find out if an approved oral pain medication may be useful in treating people who are experiencing moderate to severe acute low back pain that extends down to the lower leg.
- To compare the effects (both good and bad) against another approved pain medication.

You may be eligible to participate if you:

- Are 18 years of age or older, male or non-pregnant, non-lactating female
- Are experiencing moderate to severe low back pain that extends down the leg, below the knee
- Have had recent onset of pain, not longer than 30 days ago

Eligible study participants will be:

- Reimbursed for study-related expenses (e.g., travel, parking and meals)
- Provided research related medical care and medication at no cost
